GARDEN ROOM MINI SHOWS – APRIL, MAY AND JUNE 2021

RULES

- 1 The Shows will be held in the Garden Room with strict adherence to the Covid19 rules and regulations relevant on the date of each Show. Exhibitors and visitors to the Show will be expected to comply fully with any reasonable request by Stewards to maintain safe distance at all times.
- 2 Entry is open and will be accepted from all age groups. Please email your entries to wha-shows@outlook.com by 2:00pm on the **Saturday** prior to the Mini Show.
- 3 The entry fee will be 50p per class entered, payable on the day. The fee will be waived for exhibitors under the age of 18 years. Please bring correct money.
- 4 Staging will take place on the Sunday between 10:00 and 12:00. There will be a one-way system in operation to allow for whatever social distancing regulations are in place at the time. Distance will be marshalled. Please be patient if you are asked to queue.
- 5 The Garden Room is sheltered but is open air. If it is going to rain a gazebo will be erected. But please remember wind when considering height of your exhibits.
- 6 The exhibits will be judged between 12:00 and 13:30.
- 7 Exhibitors and visitors will be welcome to return at 13:30 to view the results
- 8 The Mini Show will close at 16:00
- 9 If you cannot remove your exhibits by 16:30 please arrange for a friend to collect.
- 10 Winners names will be published on the website and local press.
- 11 To comply with covid safety and avoid the risk of congestion we will not be serving refreshments until the June Show when the Trading Store will be fully open.
- 12 Car parking on site is limited to allotment holders only. There is limited car parking available in the road nearby but in order to avoid upsetting the neighbours, visitors are encouraged to park in the Hospital car park opposite Ormonde Road.
- 13 The committee will not accept liability for any accident, loss or damage that may occur
- 14 In the absence of any specific rules, those stated in the Show Schedule 2020 will apply.
- 15 Show Managers are Pauline MacBrayne and Sheila McKeand. Their decision is final!

SCHEDULE

Sunday 25 April

- 1 Any fruit or vegetable (including herbs) that you have grown – any quantity and any mixture of produce, displayed within a 45 x 30 cm frame (supplied). Will be judged on quality and display
- 2 Flowering plant in growing pot (can be indoor or outdoor plant – please clean outside of pot)
- 3 Rhubarb, 3 sticks – please leave base intact but trim leaves to 7.5cm
- 4 Marble Cake – [using this recipe](#) and omitting the icing. Please display under WHA cake dome (supplied) and note that baking time is 50-60 minutes

Sunday 23 May

- 1 Any fruit or vegetable (including herbs) that you have grown – any quantity and any mixture of produce, displayed within a 45 x 30 cm frame (supplied). Will be judged on quality and display
- 2 Flowering plant in growing pot (can be indoor or outdoor plant – please clean outside of pot)
- 3 A Memory from Lockdown – something you have made, created, written or photographed that will become a positive memory of your experience during lockdown
- 4 Seasonal flowers you have grown, displayed in own vase

Sunday 27 June

- 1 Home-grown Strawberries, 10
- 2 Your own grown roses in own container, arranged for effect – any number of stems
- 3 Specimen flower (any) in own container
- 4 Seasonal fruit, vegetable and flower collection (including herbs) any quantity and any mixture of produce, displayed within a 45 x 30 cm frame (supplied). Will be judged on quality and display
- 5 Looking Forward – an exhibit that captures your aspiration for the post lockdown world
